## TEST WATER SHUTDOWN

From 11:59pm on Monday, July 9<sup>th</sup>  
To 5:00am on Tuesday, July 10<sup>th</sup>

### On Broadway

- From W. 69<sup>th</sup> Street to W. 72<sup>nd</sup> Street

**\*WE ANTICIPATE RESIDENTS ON THE FOLLOWING BLOCKS TO BE AFFECTED\***

West Side of Broadway, from W. 69<sup>th</sup> to W. 70<sup>th</sup> Street  
 East Side of Broadway, from W. 70<sup>th</sup> to W. 71<sup>st</sup> Street  
 West Side of Broadway, from W. 71<sup>st</sup> to W. 72<sup>nd</sup> Street

**WHY IS MY WATER BEING TURNED OFF? :** A water shutdown is necessary to facilitate the relocation of a 12" water main. On occasion, work may be completed earlier and water service restored.

**SOME THINGS TO REMEMBER:**

The DDC recommends that you shut off the water main valve in your house/building in order to avoid problems that may occur/when sediment enters or is released from your plumbing.

You are asked to shut off all WATER cooled appliances, which may include air conditioners, etc.

Once water service is returned, turn the main house valve back on and flush the system by running your faucets to sinks & tubs for about 15 to 30 mins.
