Remove or overturn containers capable of holding water (for example tire piles, urns, vases, buckets, etc.).
Ensure that roof gutters are cleared of debris and roof is free of standing water.
Sweep away puddles that last more than 5 days.
Fill in holes or trenches in the ground.
Regrade or repave roads, paths and/or walkways to avoid accumulating water.
Redesign and/or repair inadequate drainage systems.
Apply for larvicide permit, as necessary
Have licensed applicators apply larvicide to catch basins and water bodies in the property.
Advise employees on occupational health and safety protocols and provide personal protective equipment as necessary.
