- Sixth Avenue between 42nd and 59th streets
- Central Park South between Fifth Avenue and Columbus Circle/Central Park West

Street Closures (no vehicular traffic)

- 6:00 a.m.: Central Park West (59th Street-77th Street)
- 8:00 a.m.: Central Park West (77th Street-85th Street)
- 8:00 a.m.: Broadway (all lanes) between Columbus Circle and 65th Street

Central Park Transverses closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic

- 9:00 a.m.: 79th Street
- 9:00 a.m.: 65th-66th Street

Crosstown traffic will be detoured south to 57th Street and north to 86th Street Transverse.

No Parking and Road Closures

There will be no parking on the following dates/times and locations:

No Parking 12:01 a.m.–8:00 p.m.

- Central Park West (59th Street to 86th Street, both sides of street)
- West 61st Street to West 69th Street; West 71st Street to West 72nd Street between Central Park West and Broadway/Columbus Avenue (both sides of street)

Road Closures

- Please be advised that **Broadway northbound will be closed completely to traffic** from: Columbus Circle to West 65th Street on Sunday by the NYPD from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., due to concerns about pedestrian overcrowding in the streets
- 6:00 a.m.–6:00 p.m.: Central Park West between West 59th Street and West 77th Street from Central Park West to Broadway/Columbus Avenue
- 8:00 a.m.–6:00 p.m.: Central Park West between West 77th Street to West 85th Street from Central Park West to Columbus Avenue
- 9:00 a.m.–9:00 p.m.: West 65th Street/West 66th Street & West 79th Street Transverses
- Crosstown traffic will be detoured around the park, south to West 57th Street or north to 86th Street Transverse and West 142nd Street
- The 86th Street Transverse will be open all day

Neighborhood Residents

You will be able to enter your area of residence via the sidewalks on West 61st Street to West 66th Street. NYPD will require proof of residence by a government ID to gain access.

Need to walk your dog?

Access to parts of Central Park will be restricted on Sunday, November 3.

- Columbus Circle entrance to Central Park will be open throughout the day and the public will be able to walk east. Please note that this area will become very crowded during the day as this is the main entrance to the TCS New York City Marathon finish area viewing. Subject to closure at discretion of NYPD due to crowd size.
- No Columbus Circle access from Central Park West
- No park access from north of Columbus Circle to West 72nd Street from 1:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- No park access from West 72nd Street to West 85th Street from 5:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

The public may access the park on the west side at West 86th Street during the hours that the park is closed from West 59th Street to West 85th Street.
